Travel Awards:

Travel awards at \$1,000 are available on a competitive basis. The travel award includes waived workshop fee.

Eligibility Criteria

- The goal of this travel award is to diversify the research workforce. Therefore, consistent with the NIH's Interest in Diversity (NOT-OD-20-031: Notice of NIH's Interest in Diversity), the underrepresented emerging scholars (doctoral students, postdoctoral scholars, assistant professors) are highly encouraged to apply for this travel award.
- Priority will be given to candidates whose applications demonstrate
 - 1) research excellence that is appropriate to their career stage AND
 - 2) a serious commitment to initiating a research program focused on comparative life course research
- Applicants must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application Requirements

- A curriculum vitae
- A cover letter describing a) how the workshop complements your research agenda (no more than 250 words) and b) a proposed research project description of a comparative life course project for which the workshop would be beneficial (no more than 400 words).
